

Precept Study: Once Saved Always Saved? True or False?

In Regards to, the teaching that once a professing believer is saved, they are always saved. Many would like to believe this, but in actuality and reality – throughout scripture we clearly see that this is Not the case! Many people forfeit their inheritance, their very own Salvation by denying the Lord. We are taught through scripture that not all who are called, are truly chosen. Many will claim the Lord, claim to be a Christian – but will Not do the things that the Lord instructs them to do, as a “Christian”.

*This bible study shares key scriptures that home in on the fact, that not everyone is genuine in their profession of faith. Those who are not are fake and truly enemies of the Lord and will be treated as such in the judgment. **Will you set yourself apart?***

As it is written;

* The LORD hath appeared of old unto me, *saying*, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee. (Jer 31:3 KJV)

* Now the just shall live by faith: but if *any man* draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. (Heb 10:38 KJV)

* For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ. (Jud 1:4 KJV)

* ... these are they which are sown among thorns; such as hear the word, (Mar 4:18 KJV)

* And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful. (Mar 4:19 KJV)

* Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. (Mat 7:21 KJV)

* Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? (Mat 7:22 KJV)

* And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. (Mat 7:23 KJV)

- * ... they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness; (Mar 4:16 KJV)
- * And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended. (Mar 4:17 KJV)
- * But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven. (Mat 10:33 KJV)
- * For many are called, but few *are* chosen. (Mat 22:14 KJV)
- * ... by their fruits ye shall know them. (Mat 7:20 KJV)
- * But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul. (Heb 10:39 KJV)
- * Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord. (1Co 15:58 KJV)
- * As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, *so* walk ye in him: (Col 2:6 KJV)
- * Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. (Heb 10:22 KJV)
- * Let us hold fast the profession of *our* faith without wavering; (for he *is* faithful that promised;) (Heb 10:23 KJV)
- * Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ; (Tit 2:13 KJV)
- * Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. (Tit 2:14 KJV)
- * For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, (Heb 10:26 KJV)

- * But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries. (Heb 10:27 KJV)
- * ... *it is* impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, (Heb 6:4 KJV)
- * And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, (Heb 6:5 KJV)
- * If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put *him* to an open shame. (Heb 6:6 KJV)
- * He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: (Heb 10:28 KJV)
- * Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace? (Heb 10:29 KJV)
- * Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous. (1Jo 3:7 KJV)
- * He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil. (1Jo 3:8 KJV)
- * Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? (Rom 6:16 KJV)
- * Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: ... (1Co 6:9 KJV)
- * For the time *is come* that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if *it first begin* at us, what shall the end *be* of them that obey not the gospel of God? (1Pe 4:17 KJV)
- * And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? (1Pe 4:18 KJV)
- * ... having loved this present world, ... (2Ti 4:10 KJV)

- * Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power; (2Th 1:9 KJV)
- * In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: (2Th 1:8 KJV)
- * If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, *and* prepared unto every good work. (2Ti 2:21 KJV)
- * ... the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever. (1Jo 2:17 KJV)
- * ... but he that **doeth** the will of God abideth for ever. (1Jo 2:17 KJV)
